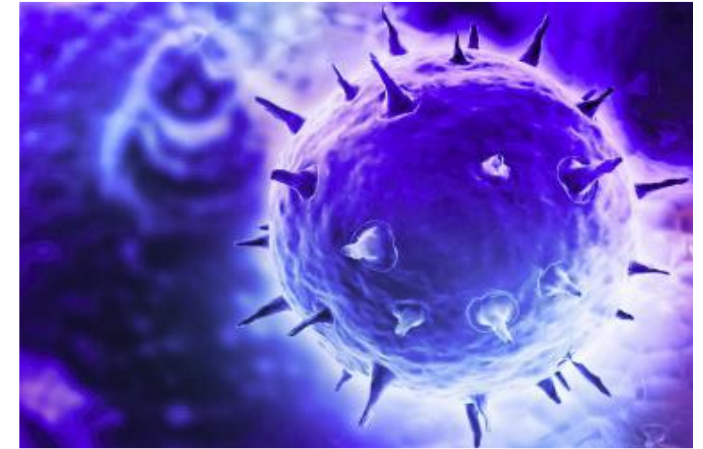
Education

The Department of BT has courses which cover field knowledge, general culture and pedagogical knowledge. The duration of education in the department is 4 years and the courses in the programme are instructed both at theoretical and practical levels and dimensions. Apart from the undergraduate programme, related MA and doctoral programmes have been organised and directed by the Institute of Educational Sciences.

Facilities

The Department of BT has a dual agreement for an Exchange programme at the undergraduate and graduate levels with the Faculty of Education of the University of Weingarten in Germany.

Besides, many studies and programmes have been run with some international and national vocational institutions such as NARST, IHPST and FEAD. The students who are eligible for the necessary conditions can attend the double-major programmes.



Employment Prospects

Our graduates can work as biology teachers private and state schools. The ones who have the required qualifications can attend the graduate programmes in biology, botanic, pharmacy, bio-chemistry, anatomy and similar disciplines at home abroad.
