Geography Teacher Education Department [CÖABD] has been continuing education and training activities since foundation of Marmara University. The training period is 4 years for the Geography Teacher Education Department and graduated from university with a bachelor's degree.

Education and Teaching

The undergraduate program consists of courses related to field knowledge (geography), general culture and pedagogical formation. Courses in the department are theoretical and practical. In addition, master's and doctoral programs are also carried out within the Institute of Educational Sciences.

Atatürk Faculty of Education is located on the Anatolian side of the İstanbul in Göztepe Campus which is one of the most important metropolis in the world. In this respect, our students have a great advantage in terms of using the
