Department of Elementary Education

The Department of Elementary Teacher Education (DETE) aims to train qualified prospective teachers to teach in elementary school level, from first to fourth grade. The program includes an undergraduate and two graduate programs.

Education

Elementary Teacher Education Program requires four years of education to earn a Bachelor degree. The program offers a wide range of theoretical and applied courses for the qualification in three major areas: subject-specific knowledge, general knowledge, and pedagogical content knowledge.

In the graduate level, DETE offers master's and doctoral programs through Institute of Educational Sciences. The master's and the doctoral programs in the department have been active since 1991 and 2000, respectively.

Opportunities

Academically superior bachelor students in DETE hold opportunities to do double-major in a great variety of fields in Marmara University. Besides, through bilateral agreements with European universities in the framework of Erasmus + (Plus), the successful students in DETE are also eligible to study abroad up to a year.

Ataturk Faculty of Education where DETE resides in is located in the central campus of Marmara University in the Anatolian side of Istanbul, one of the most glamorous metropoles in the world. The university provides numerous social, cultural, educational, and sportive opportunities for its eligible students. Many activities offered in and out of campus amply satisfy students' cognitive, physical, social, and emotional needs.
