The Department of Social Studies Education

The department of social Studies teaching started offering education in the social sciences in the 1998-1999 academic year as part of the department of primary education at Marmara University. The first graduates of the department were awarded their diplomas in the 2001-2002 academic year. The department aims to train social studies teachers for the secondary schools. The department's lecturers are 3 professors, 4 associate professors, 2 assistant professors and 3 research assistants.



Education

The undergraduate program offers a 4 year education during which the student-teachers are aimed to be equipped with fieldspecific knowledge, general knowledge and pedagogical formation in theoretical and practical courses. The department conducts master's and doctoral studies within the Institute of Educational Sciences.

Facilities

The campus of Atatürk Education Faculty is located on the Anatolian side of Istanbul, one of the most important metropolitan cities in the World. Thus compared to the

students of other universities of Turkey, our students have great advantage of getting much easier Access to all kinds of social, cultural, educational and sporting activities. These opportunities enhance our students' cognitive, affective and psycho-motor development.

Employment Prospects
