The Department of Turkish Language and Literature Teaching

(DTLLT) started operating at Marmara University as a 4 year undergraduate program in 1982. In accordance with the restructuring in 1998 supervised by the Turkish Council of Higher Education (IHE-YÖK), the duration of the program was extended from 4 to 5 years in faculties of education. But since 2014, the program again continues to give 4 years of education. The DTLLT aims at providing education for prospective teachers of Turkish Language and Literature who will work at institutions of secondary education.



Education

The undergraduate program of the department consists of course on topics regarding field-specific knowledge, general culture and pedagogical formation. The period of education and training is 4 years, during which both theory and practice are covered. Students who fulfill the prerequisites can participate in a double-major program. The department also provides graduate (M.A.) and doctorate (Ph.D.) programs offered through the institute

of Educational Sciences.

Facilities

The campus of Atatürk Education Faculty is located on the Anatolian side of Istanbul, one of the most important metropolitan cities in the world. Thus, compared to the students of other universities in Turkey, our students have the great advantage of getting much easier access to all kinds of social, cultural, educational and sporting activities.



Employment Prospect

Graduates are entitled to teach at government and private institutions of secondary education and the private study centers. They can also work as experts at several research centers and institutes or as newspaper and journal editors.
