Admissions for non-environmental engineering majors



We welcome applicants from both engineering and non-engineering disciplines. Applicants who have earned a Bachelor's degree in a field other than Environmental Engineering are required to take a **one-year** Scientific Preparation Program. Admissions committee may decide on the number of courses to be taken within the program (max. 30 ECTS credits) based on the transcript and GPA of the candidate.

Admission decisions

Decisions are based on departmental review, using a combination of factors, including academic degrees and records, test scores, a written scientific evaluation exam and interview.
