1. Do not copy information word for word from a source, without using quotation marks and giving proper acknowledgment of the source or providing a proper citation.
2. Do not paraphrase the text of a source without providing proper acknowledgment of the source or providing a proper citation. The paraphrasing leads the reader of the text to believe that the ideas and arguments presented are one's own.
3. Do not paraphrase extensive portions of another source, even with citation. The extensive paraphrasing leads the reader of one's own text to believe that the ideas and arguments presented are one's own or it results in one's own contribution to the work being minimal.
4. Do not reproduce without proper citation, any other form of work of another person such as a graph, experimental data or results, laboratory reports, a proof, or a problem solution, in full or in part.
5. Do not falsify data collected during a research activity.
6. Do not present falsified data in the report
7. Do not make up a source for a citation.
8. Do not cite a source the writer did not use.
