In 2008, the Department was transferred to the Faculty of Arts and Sciences and since then it has been operating under the Faculty's administration.

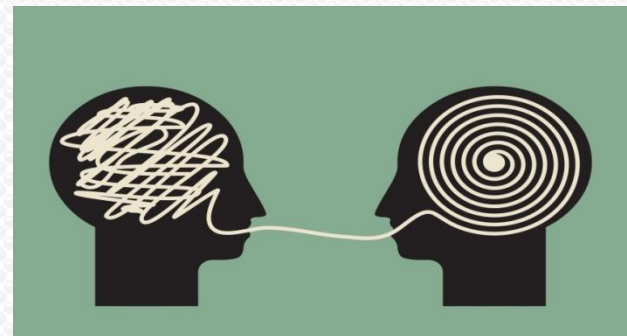
