Sakıp Sabancı Museum: The museum hosted the world-famous Catalan artist Joan Miro's "Women, Birds, Stars" collection. That exhibition ended on March 8, 2015. But you can go anytime to see the permanent collections "The Arts of The Book and Calligraphy" and "Turkish Painting from the Ottoman Reformation to the Republic."

SALT Beyoğlu: “A Century of Centuries” is an esoteric, multimedia exhibition on display until May 24, 2015.



Istanbul Modern: Istanbul Modern Art Museum is the first of its kind in Turkey. You can visit the permanent collection “Past and Future,” and also “Painter and Painting: A Mehmet Güteryüz Retrospective” that will be exhibited until June 28, 2015.

Pera Museum: Study on “Life Is Short, Art Long: The Art of Healing in Byzantium.” And also take advantage of your visit to consider the first major exhibition of sculptor and painter Alberto Giacometti in Turkey, here until April 26, 2015.
