Bukhari's Sahih; Major approaches about faith and Bukhari's view on faith; The relationship between Faith, practice, religion, and Islam. Definition of faith and issues related to faith. The relationship between "trustworthiness, generosity, altruism" and faith/Islam. Signs of mature faith. Superiority of believers to each other in regards to their deeds; modesty-faith relationship. The relationship between faith-practice, Islam-faith, and Salam-Islam. Sin-faith relationship; and the question of attributing disbelief to a sinner. Difference among sins; Kufr meaning ingratitude and Shirk meaning oppression. Signs of hypocrisy. Dependence of actions on intention; and its relationship with faith. Increase and decrease in faith; And an observable life free from extremism. Belittling and insistence on sins and its relationship with faith. The relationship between Faith-Islam and Ihsan according to hadith of Gabriel; Faith-Intention and the significance of intention in actions.

The thematic tafsir. Tafsir approaches that emerged in the historical process: Sectarian, Sufic, Jurisprudential, Scientific, Social, Modernist. The tafsir methodology and its main sources. Writing of the Qur'an, compiling and reproducing. To put haraka and point to the Qur'an, the composition of the Qur'an text, the recitation (kiraah) and seven harf of the qur'an. The sciences about the text of the Qur'an: Uslub al-Qur'an, Mubhamat al-Qur'an, Gareeb al-Qur'an, Vucuuu and Nazaaer, Aksam al-Kur'ân. The sciences about the meaning of the Qur'an: Mutashaabih al-Qur'an, Huruuf al-Mukattaa, I'caaz al-Qur'an, Mushkel al-Qur'ân, Takrar al-Qur'an, Majaz al-Qur'an, Munasabat al-Qur'an, Fadael al-Qur'an. The historical sciences: Kisas al-Qur'an, Asbaab al-Nuzuul, Naaseh and Mansuuh. The basic principles of the understanding and interpreting of the Qur'an.
